

iPhone and iPad Group Monthly Report - June 2024

This month we learnt about the changes in the options for access to the internet in Teesdale. The major change is the availability of fibre broadband direct to the majority of premises in the area.

We then moved on to the benefits of using the Health app on the iPhone, providing first responder access to medical information and recording 'do not resuscitate' requests.

Access to emergency medical assistance may be available on your mobile even if there is no signal. Any mobile network will allow '999' calls. If that does not work, iPhones 14 and 15 will allow emergency calls via low altitude satellite networks; this was demonstrated via a live demo. Communicating via this system is like holding a text conversation.
