We then worked on the light and shade of the lighthouse itself and then, using an indigo blue, painted the sea...again lifting out where needed with a dry brush. The rocks and grasses were then painted using a variety of ochres and greens, and Martin photographed us all at work for the first time. We really enjoyed this session which was punctuated with the obligatory tea and biscuits.
