We had two wildflower walks in June, both to meadows before they are cut for hay - Hannah's Meadow and the Demesnes.

At Hannah's Meadow we identified 23 flowers with much discussion about two in particular: Cat's Ear or False Dandelion and Changing/Discolour Myosotis which is a type of Forget-me-knot.

On the Demesnes we identified 44 flowers and were thrilled to find not one but two Orchids, Common Spotted and Marsh.
