Wildflower Report for August.

Due to the intense heat on Wednesday, 11th August our wildflower walk along Ramshaw Railway was postponed to the following Wednesday, 20th August when 6 of us identified 40 flowers on a considerably cooler day.

We identified some that were unusual or new to us - Sticky Groundsel, Common Hempnettle, Black Nightshade, Bird's Eye Speedwell, Common Toadflax and Common lambsquarters. We also came across Sweet Alyssum which is a wild flower but is more commonly cultivated as a garden plant.

A complete list of the flowers identified has been sent to the Group members.
